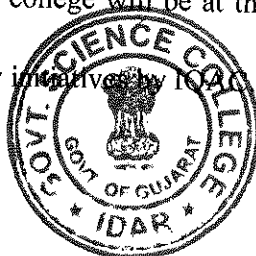

### TO PROMOTE RESEARCH AND INNOVATION

The general objective of this Memorandum of Understanding (MOU) is to stimulate and facilitate the development of collaborative and mutually beneficial programs which serve to enhance the intellectual life and cultural development on both campuses, and to contribute to increase academic co-operation. Thus, Government Science College, Idar and Shree Pramukh Swami Community Science Centre, Badoli have agreed that in support of their mutual interests in the field of education and research:

1. The two Educational Institution will:
  - a). Co-operate in the exchange of information relating to their activities in teaching and research in fields of mutual interests;
  - b). Promote appropriate joint research projects and join courses for study.
  - c). Organize conferences, seminar, workshops and symposia
  - d). Endeavor to encourage students and staff to spend periods of time in the host college under the exchange program
  - e). Conduct study tours, mutually agreed in writing between the parties prior to commencement of this activity.
2. Facilitate the exchange of undergraduate students. The academic standing of such students shall be determined by the host college. Exchange students will be accorded the rights and privileges of students in the host campus in accordance with the regulations of the host college relating to students and will be admitted under the terms and conditions relevant to the host college.  
Accreditation for the academic work carried out by an undergraduate student during the period of study at the host college will be at the direction of the student's home college.
3. Colleges will take some quality initiatives by IOAC



4. Colleges may share some of the learning resources for the benefit of the students.
5. The aim of the Memorandum of Understanding shall be to achieve a broad balance in the respective contributions and benefits of the collaboration, and this shall be subject to periodic review by both colleges.
6. In implementation of specific co-operative programs, a written agreement covering all relevant aspects including funding and the obligations to be undertaken by each party will be negotiated, mutually agreed and formalized in writing, prior to the commencement of the program.

This agreement will take effect from the date of its signing and shall be valid for six academic years period from that date unless sooner terminated, revoked or modified by mutual written agreement between the parties, and may be extended by mutual written agreement.

Either party may terminate the Agreement at any time during tile term by the provision of three months written notice to the other party.

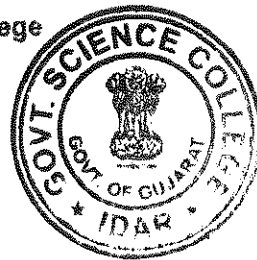


